How to Apply to Overbrook Educational Center:

OEC is a lottery school. In order to be accepted into OEC, you must apply online. The entire process should take no more than 10 minutes to complete.

For the 18-19 school year we are full. To apply to be accepted for the 19-20 school year, site selection opens on September 21, 2018 at 5:00pm. The process closes on November 2nd, 2018. There is no other way to register your child for Overbrook Educational Center except online.

If you have multiple children at OEC, you **MUST** still apply for your child's sibling to have a chance of being accepted. In order to apply for kindergarten for the 19-20 school year, your child must have turned 5 years old by September 1st, 2018.

In order to apply for your child to be accepted to OEC, you must log on to philasd.org and follow the steps beginning on September 21st, 2018. There is no admission criteria *except* for the fact that you **must live** in the city of Philadelphia in order to attend OEC. Finally, all decisions are made through the office of student enrollment for student admittance and families must apply online. Finally, ensure that you click the **CORRECT** grade that your child will be entering in September, 2019, when completing the online application.

Students may wear sweaters that go over their uniforms (cardigans) during fall and winter months that are either white, grey, red, or black solid colors.4. For Gym: All Black or Grey Sweats / T-Shirts / Sweatshirts. Please ensure students wear sneakers.5. If a hooded sweatshirt is worn, at no point during the school day should the hood be up over a child's head.6. We have gently used uniforms at OEC and we are always looking for more. <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Cell Phones</u></p> <p>If a child brings a cell phone to school, the phone is to be turned off between the hours of entry and exit from 8:30am-3:09pm (and any after school program hours). From 8:00am-8:20am, a child may use his/her phone to listen to music or play an educationally appropriate game. Between 8:20-8:30 we will remind students to turn their phones to silent and put away. If a cell phone is discovered in use or in sight, any authority figure may gently remind the student to put away their cell phone. If a child does not comply with the directive the first time, the staff member may confiscate the cell phone and the child may retrieve it at the end of the day. Upon the second sighting of the cell phone out or in use, a parent/guardian will be contacted and requested to come to school to retrieve the cell phone on the same day that the cell phone was discovered in sight or in use. Per School District Policy, inappropriate use of an electronic device immediately warrants an in-school suspension. Upon the third infraction of sight or use of a cell phone between the hours of 8:30am and 3:09pm, the phone will be taken, held, and returned at the conclusion of the school year.</p>	

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
