
Attendance Information



PARENTS: Please read carefully, and then take the short "quiz" linked at the bottom to be entered for a chance to win a \$25 gift card!

- **EVERY** time that a child is absent from school, the school needs a note from the parent explaining the reason for the absence. * This note needs to be written within 3 days of the student's absence
- A child is considered "illegally absent" until a note is received but there are only certain reasons that a student can miss school. * legal absences: illness of child, doctor's appointment, funeral of family member, observance of religious holiday, family emergency
- If a child is "out sick" for 3 or more days in a row, they need a note from their doctor.
- Once a student is ILLEGALLY absent IO days in a school year, that child is considered chronically truant and can be referred to truancy court.
- At OEC, we are looking for children to have 95% attendance or better for the school year. This means, each child can miss no more than 9 days in a year.
- Studies show that students who have good attendance are: likely to get better grades, likely to get
 a better job, more likely to stay out of trouble, more likely to graduate from high school.
