

## OEC Fact Power! Our Kids will be Fact Famous


Our goal as a school is that every student in grades 3rd-8th will be "Fact Famous" by the end of the year by knowing their multiplication and division facts from 2-12 with automaticity! To do this, they need to practice their triangle fact cards each night. Every Wednesday they will have a chance to "flex" their power with a problem set challenge.

Dear Parents and Students.


The importance of knowing our multiplication and division facts automatically-what we call fast Paver, cannot be overstated. As we propress through math, more emphasis will be placed on comptee problems have require multiple steps to complete. Without Fact Paver, students' attention is taken away from the concepts being taught in order to figure out a multiplication of whom fact. For example, when we learn long division or fractions, students must be able to come up with the answer to multiplication facts all the context of that higher order algorithm. Less than automatic recall will inhibit a students' ability to succeed with these types of skills.

To make the task more manageable, we're going to focus on one set of math facts at a time. Today, your child came home with the trangles for their 2s multiplication facts. Students will have one seed to prove that they have mastered these facts. For some students, it may take longer, and that's okay. Oxeksing in weekly will allow us to see where students are with their facts. Only when Fact Power is demonstrated on one set of a students and their facts are students, then their facts. 

## **Board Goals and Guardrails 22-23 Update**

#### Goals

- The percentage of 3-8 grade students who are proficient on the state ELA assessment will grow to 65.0% by August 2025. We scored 42.1% in 2022.
- The percentage of 3rd grade students who are proficient on the state ELA assessment will grow to 62.0% by August 2025. We scored 33.5% in 2022.
- The percentage of 3-8 grade students who are proficient on the state math assessment will grow to 52.0% by August 2025. We scored 11.5% in 2022.

#### **Guardrails**
